

Advanced Mandala and Cave Art Workshop

September 15 - 18th, 2017

A Four Day Glass Workshop with Richard La Londe in his Studio

Friday, Saturday, Sunday, Monday 9:30 am – 5:00 pm Spectacular Daily Lunch Provided

This is an advanced workshop and we will work on a larger scale.

We begin by designing a Mandala and over three days using "tested compatible" Bullseye 3 mm and 6 mm sheet glass, crushed glass frit mixtures, the liquid glass line method, multiple firings, we will create glass tiles. Using a rotary diamond engraver we will etch a pattern into silver foil and fuse into glass tiles. Then we will fabricate an aluminum mounting system and adhere these tiles into a pattern to create our 14" x 14" Mandala wall piece.

On the fourth day we will use a digital stencil cutter along with the liquid glass line and silver foil to create imagery for our multi-layer $10'' \times 10''$ Cave Painting which we will mount on aluminum for wall hanging.

This is an opportunity to study and interact with a pioneer in glass fusing and author of **Richard La Londe: Fused Glass Art and Technique**, and **Richard La Londe & Friends** - **Book II**, in his own studio located about 1 1/2 hours from downtown Seattle including a short ferry ride to Whidbey Island.

This four day workshop is \$850, which includes materials and a spectacular lunch each day. A \$425 deposit is required to register and the balance of \$425 is due 30 days before the class starts. Experience in basic glass cutting and fusing is required.
